Our program for your trip:

Wednesday: Arrival in Bratislava & Festival Opening

Upon arrival in Bratislava, **check-in to your booked accommodation.** Meet your local **festival assistant** for a brief welcome meeting.

Individual workshops for ensembles (upon request only and for additional charge).

Evening: Festival Opening Concert at St. Martin's Cathedral in Bratislava's old town. Each choir is invited to present a sacred a cappella music program or with piano accompaniment (duration 5 minutes).

Group dinner at a local restaurant.

Thursday: Competition & Festival Concerts

Breakfast at accommodation.

Morning: Competition concerts at the historic Mirror Hall of the Primate's Palace.

Orchestras will have the possibility to enjoy a guided city walk through Bratislava's Old Town.

Free time for individual lunch.

Afternoon: Festival concerts for all non-competitive choirs at Mirror Hall of the Primate's Palace.

Evening: Open-air festive concerts for all orchestras on Bratislava's main square.

Friday: Orchestra Competition, Festival Concerts & Closing Ceremony

Breakfast at accommodation.

Morning: Orchestra competition concerts in the Slovakian Radio Station. Choirs will have the possibility to enjoy a guided city walk **through Bratislava's Old Town.**Free time for individual lunch.

Afternoon: Festival concerts at the Klarisky Music Hall followed by public open-air concerts at the Hviezdoslav Square.

Evening: Award Ceremony at the Hviezdoslav Square, all participating groups will receive a participation certificate.
