Festival program

Day 1: Individual Arrival - Check-In

Upon arrival in Vienna, check into your booked accommodation.

Evening: Group dinner at accommodation.

Day 2: Sightseeing – Rathauskeller – Free Afternoon

Morning: Breakfast at accommodation.

After that, enjoy a half day guided city tour of Vienna followed by group lunch at the Vienna City Hall Restaurant (Restaurant Rathauskeller - TBC).

Afternoon: Free time and individual dinner.

Day 3: Free Morning - Concert at the Vienna City Hall

Morning: Breakfast at accommodation and free morning in Vienna individual sightseeing or shopping.

Afternoon: Concerts at the Vienna Town Hall as part of Vienna's International Advent Singing Festival (30 minutes/choir incl. stage entrance and exit – piano will be provided).

Evening: Free time and individual dinner.

Day 4: Mass Service – Free Afternoon – Heuriger Evening

Morning: Breakfast at accommodation followed by participation to a morning mass service in one of Vienna's numerous churches (on request).

Afternoon: Free afternoon.

Evening: Experience an evening at a traditional Viennese Heuriger, a cozy wine tavern where locals and visitors gather to enjoy good wine, music, and singing in a charming, traditional atmosphere. You will be served a classic Heuriger platter, featuring a delicious assortment of sausages, tender pork knuckle, poultry, and savory cabbage—perfectly complementing the local wine and the authentic Viennese experience.
